

# Brachial Plexus Injury (BPI)

### Course Description

The number of obstetrical Brachial Plexus Injuries (BPI) is increasing, creating critical responsibility for medical teams to provide appropriate education and support for full recovery. This class will instruct participants on conservative management of BPI and will cover several approaches.

The course will begin with an anatomy overview and mechanisms of injury to address appropriate assessment procedures, intervention stages, and availability of treatments. This course will highlight information necessary to determine the intervention approach and implement the protection stage of movement to facilitate the best outcomes. Participants will also learn how to manage care strategies when normalcy cannot be restored due to total paralysis requiring surgical intervention. The course will also detail family support and education recommendations
